Town Website-The Town's website will need to be ADA compliant in 2027. David is investigating several options and needs additional information.

New Business- The State of Vermont will no longer have smaller towns have their own Forest Fire Warden. Springfield is ours currently, but we could appoint a Deputy Forest Fire Warden.

Emergency management doesn't address the need, in some cases, for sheltering pets during disasters. Vermont does have VDART, but they can't accommodate livestock or exotic animals like reptiles. There is a hazardous training meeting on July 24, 2025.
